Our wine, like Dixie & Bass, is more than meets the eye and best enjoyed with your Dixie or your Bass.

MAGICAL SOILS

The Columbia Valley is home to the most storied AVA's in Washington state, and in Dixie & Bass, grapes are sourced from the Columbia Valley region adjacent to the prestigious Red Mountain AVA. Predominantly south-facing, Washington's largest viticultural region couples warm sun and great drainage, thanks to the Columbia River, to produce wines that are fruit-forward, yet retain some of the structure of European wines.

TASTING NOTES

Equal parts savory herb, baking spice and ripe fruit on the nose with hints of dried tarragon, red cherry, espresso and vanilla. Inviting on the fore palate with fruit and dried herb leading to a round soft mid palate dominated by rich, chewy tannins and bright red fruit. A long, clean finish showcasing the wine's complexity and rich tannins invites another sip.
