WINEMAKING

Grapes were delicatley hand picked, destemmed and fermented on the skins for ten days before being aged for 19 months in New American Oak.

TASTING NOTES

Red cherry and fresh herb on the nose with hints of crushed stone and mocha. Bright and pleasing on the palate, with a generous fruit driven mid palate and a long, clean finish.

PAIRINGS

Pairs well with cured hams like serrano, prosciutto or sliced country ham.
