#### STORY

This allows us to consistently produce some of the best wines the world has to offer.

### WINEMAKING

Grapes were delicatley hand picked, destemmed and fermented on the skins for three weeks before being aged for 20 months in New American Oak.

#### TASTING NOTES

Blackberries and plums with savory herb on the nose and hints of dried earth and espresso bean. Broad and generous on the palate with pronounced savory notes on the mid palate. Framed by dense tannins, leading to a long, fruit driven finish.

## PAIRINGS

Pair with a rack of lamb, roast veal, or filet mignon.
